



Code of Ethics of The Foundation for Shamanic Studies

- ◆ Refrain from taking advantage of students by virtue of their positions as faculty members, avoiding inappropriate personal relationships, including those of a sexual nature. The Foundation also advises those engaged in shamanic practice to follow the same guidelines with their clients.
- ◆ Carefully consider their actions as teachers, treating self and others with care, patience, tolerance, and compassion.
